IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Safety

All Otter Week Entrants whenever going afloat and coming ashore must tally on and off.

Buoyancy aids must be worn by all Otter Week Entrants at all times on the pontoon and while afloat. Suitable footwear must be worn at all times when on the pontoon.

Any boat entered for Otter Week must have a suitable painter for towing.

Safety boat crews may instruct any boat to go ashore as necessary.

Parental Responsibility

Parents/Guardians remain responsible for their children at all times. If you are unable to remain on site please ensure that you advise the Otter Week Administrator of the name of the person who has agreed to be responsible for your child(ren) in your absence.

Insurance

All boats entered for Otter Week must have Third Party Liability Insurance cover of at least £3,000,000.

Sailing Instructions

All racing entrants are advised to refer to the Sailing Instructions published on the Otter Week webpage. A paper copy of the Sailing Instructions may be obtained at the start of Otter Week from the Administrator or Race Officer.
