**NOTICE OF RACE**

**1 RULES**

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 Notice of Race.
- 1.3 Crouch Harbour Authority Byelaws available at registration.
- 1.4 Sailing Instructions and any amendments thereto.
- 1.5 Racing Rule 35 and A4 will be changed as follows Boats failing to finish within 15 minutes after the first boat sails the course and finishes will be scored Did Not Finish.
- 1.6 Racing Rule 40 will be changed as follows RRS 40 is modified to read will wear personal buoyancy at all times while afloat for the duration of the event.
- 1.7 All boats shall use the insurance provided by the organising authority for the weekend.

**2 ADVERTISING**

- 2.1 The Organizing Authority (OA) will supply, and install bow decals, which shall be affixed to the bow and boom. It is the responsibility of competitors to ensure that these are properly in place before leaving the pontoon each day.
- 2.2 No individual advertising will be allowed.
- 2.3 The OA shall require all participating boats to display the event sponsors' advertising, in compliance with World Sailing Regulation 20.

**3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 3.1 The regatta is by invitation only.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the form sent with their invitation sending it, together with the required fee, to Royal Corinthian Yacht Club by 1<sup>st</sup> October 2019
- 3.3 RS 200 supplied by the competitors will be raced in the 2019 event.
- 3.4 The following restrictions on the number of boats apply 30 boats.

## **8 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The sailing instructions will be available from the RCYC website and at registration.

## **9 VENUE**

Racing shall be in the Rivers Crouch and or Roach.

## **10 THE COURSES**

The courses to be sailed will be Windward Leeward.

## **11 SCORING**

### **11.1** The Low Point scoring system Appendix A will apply.

### **11.2** 3 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

### **11.3** When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

## **12 SUPPORT BOATS**

Support boats shall be marked with RCYC.

## **13 BERTHING**

Boats overnight shall be kept in their assigned places in the Corinthian boat park.

## **14 RADIO COMMUNICATION**

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

## **15 PRIZES**

Prizes will be given as follows: Endeavour Trophy (not to be taken away) and a keeper.

## **16 Media Consent: Rights to use Names & Likenesses**

- 16.1 Competitors and/or their Parents or Guardians automatically grant the Organising Authority, the Royal Corinthian Yacht Club (Endeavour Trophy 2019) and any party to which they may delegate this right, without payment the right in perpetuity to make, use and show (including via the internet), any motion pictures, still pictures, live, taped or filmed television, or any other form of media, of or relating to the event.
- 16.2. Boats may be required to carry cameras, sound equipment and positioning equipment as specified by the Organising Authority.
- 16.3. Competitors may be required for interviews at the regatta.

## **17 Risk Statement**

Rule 4 of the Racing Rules of Sailing states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone." Sailing is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk. By taking part in the event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that:

- (a) They are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves, their crew and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event;
- (b) They are responsible for the safety of themselves, their crew, their boat and their other property whether afloat or ashore;
- (c) They accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omissions;
- (d) Their boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to participate;
- (e) The provision of a race management team, patrol boat and other officials and volunteers by the event organiser does not relieve them of their own responsibilities;
- (f) The provision of patrol boat cover is limited to such assistance, particularly in extreme weather conditions, as can be practically provided in the circumstances.
