

The Royal Corinthian Yacht Club (RCYC) & Royal Burnham Yacht Club (RBYC)

Notice of Race 2020 (NoR)

For all club racing events from the Royal Corinthian Yacht Club (RCYC) and Royal Burnham Yacht Club (RBYC) as detailed on the respective club websites under RCYC, RBYC and Class specific Programmes on the dates set out there in (Programmes), where there are no other event specific Notices of Race applicable. The Organising Authority for each race will be the Club from whose line the race is started.

1. Rules

- 1.1 All racing will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020 (RRS). ^[1]_[SEP]
- 1.2 The Crouch Harbour Authority bye-laws will apply. Copies are available from the ^[1]_[SEP]Crouch Harbour Authority at the Quay, Burnham-on-Crouch, Essex, CM0 8AS and can be viewed on their website at <http://crouchharbour.org.uk/byelaws/complete/>.
- 1.3 Under RRS 87, rule 12.20 of the Class Rules of the International Dragon Class Association is changed such that the Dragon class is allowed to use an electronic depth sounder whilst racing.
- 1.4 Sailing Instructions (SI) are issued by the RCYC and RBYC for racing under this NoR and are available on the respective clubs websites.

2. Advertising

World Sailing Regulation 20, Advertising Code, shall apply, save that the Squib Class may use the spinnakers provided by the organisers of the 2018 Squib National Championships at Cowes which display that events sponsor's logo.

3. Eligibility

Racing is open to all classes of boat detailed in the Programmes that enter for racing by completing the respective RCYC and RBYC Entry Form and sending it to the respective club office with the respective fees prior to racing.

4. Fees

Race Fees for each class are set out on the respective clubs websites.

5. Qualifying Series

Classes will have series racing for various trophies throughout the sailing season as detailed in the Programmes.

6. Schedule

- 6.1 The dates of racing and number of races in a series is set out in the Programmes.
6.2 The scheduled time for the Warning Signals for each class is set out on the respective club websites and in the SI's.

7. Measurement

- 7.1 Each boat shall produce when required a valid class measurement certificate.
7.2 A boat or equipment may be inspected at any time for compliance with the class rules and sailing instructions.
7.3 On the water, a boat can be instructed by a race committee equipment inspector or measurer to proceed immediately to a designated area for inspection.

8. Venue

The RCYC and RBYC at Burnham-on-Crouch, where racing takes place in the rivers Crouch and Roach and adjacent coastal waters.

9. Prizes

Perpetual Trophies and other prizes will be awarded on the day the series finishes, at the annual prize giving ceremonies or as specified by the Fleet Class Captains and posted on the respective club websites.

10. Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in a race entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage, personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after a race.

11. Insurance

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £3,000,000.00 per incident or the equivalent.
