NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2021 – 2024 and Crouch Harbour bye-laws.

2. ELIGIBILITY and ENTRY

- 2.1 The Regatta is open to boats of the following classes;
Optimist, RS Tera, RS Feva, Cadet, Laser - all rigs and
Other Fast Handicap Boats (RS200 etc... PY 1046 - 1014)
- 2.2 Entry is by notification through Corinthian Otter trainer WhatsApp groups.

3. SCHEDULE

- 3.1 Registration is from Monday 19th to Friday 23rd April. Fleet groupings will be determined at close of registration.
- 3.2 Three races per fleet will be held on Saturday 24th April.
- 3.3 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is 10.10am.
- 3.4 The second and third races will be held as soon as practicable after completion of the previous race.

4. COURSES

Courses will be set in the River Crouch and run from a start line at the end of the Royal Corinthian Yacht Club pontoon.

5. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be adequately insured with the cover of at least £3,000,000 against third party claims.

6. DECLARATION

By signalling my intention to race through the Otter trainer WhatsApp group, I agree to be bound by the Racing Rules of Sailing and all other rules that govern this event. In



particular, I will have confirmed that I have read the Notice of Race and accept its provisions and agree that my boat will conform to the requirements set out in the Notice of Race throughout the event.

7. COVID-19: FURTHER INFORMATION

By racing, participants acknowledge that rescue by safety boat may result in a compromise of social distancing.

The RCYC changing rooms are not available – it is advised that sailors arrive changed for sailing. Toilets are available for use in compliance with RCYC sanitising and hygiene requirements.
