Notice of Race (NofR)

The notation '[NP]' in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a)

The notation '[DP]' in a rule in the NofR or Sailing Instructions (SI) means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

1 RULES

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 Crouch Harbour Authority Byelaws available at the CHA website applies.
- 1.3 All boats shall comply with the RS200 Class rules.
- 1.4 RRS 35, A5.1, A5.2 and A10 is changed as follows: A boat scored TLE shall be scored points for the finishing place one more than the points scored by the last boat that finished within the Finishing Window. This changes RRS 35, A5.1, A5.2 and A10.
- 1.5 The navigation rules of the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea (IRPCAS).
- 1.6 [DP] Competitors and support persons shall comply with any reasonable instructions from an event official.
- 1.7 All participants (competitors, support persons and officials) are expected to follow prevailing government COVID-19 guidelines and legislation, prevailing RYA guidance and any Club guidance. Participants should make their own decision on whether to participate, having regard to COVID-19.

Neither the Organising Authority nor the PRO is responsible for enforcing any measures. The Sailing Instructions may from time to time, however, include an addendum with Rules relating to COVID-19 and which will be within the jurisdiction of the Protest Committee.

2 SAILING INSTRUCCIONS

- 2.1 The sailing instructions will be available on October 1st on the RCYC web site. Printed copies will be available at registration.

3 COMMUNICATION

- 3.1 The official notice board is located at the East End of the club house
- 3.2 [DP] While racing, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The regatta is by invitation only
- 4.2 Eligible boats shall enter by completing the entry form
- 4.3 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees (See NOR 5)
- 4.4 RS200 supplied by the competitors will be raced in the 2021 event
- 4.5 The following restrictions on the number of boats is 31

5 FEES

- 5.1 Entry fees: £185.00

6 ADVERTISING

- 6.1 The OA will supply decals, which shall be affixed to the bow and boom by competitors. It is the responsibility of the competitors to ensure that these are properly in place before leaving the pontoon each day
- 6.2 [DP] No individual advertising is allowed

7 QUALIFYING SERIES AND FINAL SERIES

- 7.1 The event will consist of a single series of up to 8 races (NoR 9.3).

8.4 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race of each day is 10.25

8.5 At 9.15 on 09 September 2021 a competitor's briefing will be held outside at the Eastend of the Club house near the crane.

9 EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

9.1 The OA reserves the right to conduct measurement and safety equipment checks at any time

10 CLOTHING

10.1 Endeavour 2021 vests shall be worn at all times as the outer garment when afloat except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment.

11 VENUE

11.1 Royal Corinthian Yacht Club, Burnham on Crouch, Essex CM0 8AX

11.2 Racing area Rivers Crouch and Roach

12 COURSES

12.1 The course to be sailed will be Windward Leeward.

Boats must pass through the start finish line on each windward leg.

12.2 There is no fixed number of laps. The race will finish on a windward leg when the leading boat passes through the start finish gate for the first time after the race has been in progress for the time displayed on a board at the stern of the Committee Boat. The race may be shortened earlier using RRS 32.

12.3 The marks that may be used are as follows:

Marks 1 4p and 4s are orange inflatables Mark 1 a black inflatable. The pin end will be the mast of a committee vessel.

13 PENALTY SYSTEM

13.1 The Scoring Penalty, RRS 44.1, applies

14 SCORING

14.1 Three races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

14.2 When fewer than five races have been completed, a boat's series score is the total of her race scores.

14.3 When five or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

15 SUPPORT PERSONS VESSELS

15.1 [DP] The OA may request for these boats to use additional markers or flags,

15.2 [DP] All support person vessels, including coach, press, private and spectator boats shall register during the registration period.

15.3 In the event of an emergency the race committee may request support boats for their assistance.

16 CHARTERED OR LOANED BOATS

16.1 The Organising Authority will supply a Jib and Spinnaker.

16.2 Competitors shall supply an RS200 Class mainsail

17 BERTHING

[DP] Boats shall be kept ashore in the RCYC dinghy park

18 RISK STATEMENT

18.1 RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each

competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. **Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.**

19 INSURANCE

- 19.1 All boats shall use the insurance provided by the Organising Authority

20 PRIZES

- 20.1 Endeavour Prizes will be presented after racing on Sunday 11th October 2021
- 20.2 Prizes will include Endeavour Trophy half model and Salvors for the first six boats.
