### **Notice of Race (NoR)**

The notation '[NP]' in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a)

The notation '[DP]' in a rule means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

#### **2 RULES**

- 2.1** The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 2.2** Crouch Harbour Authority Byelaws available at the CHA website.
- 2.3** Squib class rules
- 2.4** RRS 35, A4 and A5 are changed as follows: Boats failing to finish within 15 minutes after the first boat finishes will be scored DNF
- 2.5** [DP] Competitors and support persons shall comply with any reasonable instructions from an event official.

#### **3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 3.1** The event is open to all boats of the Squib class that hold a valid measurement certificate.

**3.2** Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form found on the event webpage on the RCYC website.

**3.3** To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.

**3.4** Late entries will be accepted under the following conditions:  
Approval by the Class Captain

**6.1** The sailing instructions will be available on or before 20<sup>th</sup> May on the RCYC web site.

## **7 COMMUNICATION**

- 7.1 The online official notice board is located at [www.royalcorinthian.co.uk](http://www.royalcorinthian.co.uk)
- 7.2 [DP] All boats shall carry a VHF radio capable of communicating on channel(s) 16, 72, 37
- 7.3 On the water, the race committee will make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio using channel 72.  
If the race committee displays flag V alternate VHF channel 37 will be used.
- 7.4 [DP] While racing, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

## 9 COURSES

The race committee will lay a windward / leeward course appropriate to the conditions. Further details will be provided in the Sailing Instructions.

## 10 HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

- 10.1 Boats shall not be hauled out during the event except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee [DP].

## 11 DIVING EQUIPMENT AND PLASTIC POOLS

- 11.1 Underwater breathing apparatus and plastic pools or their equivalent shall not be used around keelboats between the preparatory signal of the first race and the end of the event

## 12 RISK STATEMENT

- 12.1 RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats,

loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. **Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.**

**13 INSURANCE**

- 13.1** Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 3 million UK pounds per incident or the equivalent.

**14 PRIZES**

- 14.1** Prizes will be given after racing on Sunday in the RCYC
