Notice of Race (NofR)

The notation '[NP]' in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a)

The notation '[DP]' in a rule in the NofR or Sailing Instructions (SI) means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

1 RULES

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 Crouch Harbour Authority Byelaws (available at the CHA website) apply.
- 1.3 All boats shall comply with the RS200 Class rules.
- 1.4 RRS 35, A5.1, A5.2 and A10 are changed as follows: A boat scored TLE shall be scored points for the finishing place, one more than the points scored by the last boat that finished within the Finishing Window. This changes RRS 35, A5.1, A5.2 and A10.
- 1.5 [DP] Competitors and support persons shall comply with any reasonable instructions from an event official.

2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1 The sailing instructions will be available on October 1st on the RCYC website.

3.2 [DP] While racing, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

4.1 The regatta is by invitation only

4.2 Eligible boats shall enter by completing the online entry form

4.3 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees (See NOR 5)

4.4 RS200 supplied by the competitors will be raced in the 2023 event

4.5 The restriction on the number of boats is 30

5 FEES

5.1 Entry fees: £225.00

6 ADVERTISING

6.1 The OA will supply decals, which shall be affixed to the bow and boom by competitors. It is the responsibility of the competitors to ensure that these are correctly in place before leaving the pontoon each day

6.2 [DP] No individual advertising is allowed.

7 QUALIFYING SERIES AND FINAL SERIES

7.1 The event will consist of a single series of up to 8 races.

8.4 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race of each day is 10:25

8.5 At 9:15 October 07th 2023, a competitor's briefing will be held the east end of the Clubhouse.

9 EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

9.1 The OA reserves the right to conduct measurement and safety equipment checks at any time for compliance with the class rules, the notice of race and sailing instructions

10 CLOTHING

10.1 [DP]Endeavour 2023 vests shall be worn at all times as the outer garment when afloat except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment.

11 VENUE

11.1 Royal Corinthian Yacht Club, Burnham on Crouch, Essex CM0 8AX

11.2 Racing area Rivers Crouch and Roach

12 COURSES

12.1 The course to be sailed will be Windward Leeward.

Boats must pass through the start line on each windward leg.

12.2 There is no fixed number of laps. The race will finish on a windward leg when the leading boat passes through the start gate for the first time after the race has been in progress for the time displayed on a board at the stern of the Committee Boat. The race may be shortened earlier using RRS 32.

13 PENALTY SYSTEM

13.1 RRS 44.1, applies

14 SCORING

14.1 The scoring system is as follows: A4 low points system.

14.2 Rule A5.3 applies.

14.3 There will be no changes to the race or series scores resulting from action, including the correction of errors initiated more than 24 hours after the results are published

15 SUPPORT PERSON VESSELS

15.1 [DP] The OA may request for these boats to use additional markers or flags.

15.2 [DP] All support person vessels, including coach, press, private, and spectator boats, shall register during the registration period.

15.3 In an emergency, the race committee may request support boats for their assistance.

16 CHARTERED OR LOANED BOATS

16.1 The Organising Authority will supply a Jib, Main Sail and Spinnaker.

17 BERTHING

17.1 [DP] Boats shall be kept ashore in the RCYC dinghy park

18 RISK STATEMENT

18.1 RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in an increased risk of injury. **Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.**

19 INSURANCE

19.1 All boats shall use the insurance provided by the Organising Authority

20 PRIZES

20.1 Endeavour Prizes will be presented after racing on Sunday, October 8th 2023

20.2 Prizes will include Endeavour Trophy half model and Salvors for the first six boats.
