You must complete and return a form prior to your boat going on a mooring.

## Keelboat Mooring Packages 2024

Squib, Elite and Dragon Package:

Includes annual mooring and storage, unlimited crane movements and annual race fees as follows;

RCOD Package:

Includes, season mooring, annual race fees, 9 x crane lifts with crane staff.

Storage ashore outside of the season is NOT included (1<sup>st</sup> March to 30<sup>th</sup> Nov)

### Terms and Conditions

1. Package applies to a single mooring and boat combination.
2. A lift is defined as a launch, a recovery or lift, scrub and immediate return.
3. All lifts must have an owner/owner's rep.... assisted lifts will incur £15 charge per staff member- except RCOD's who are included in.
4. Transport of boats to and from the crane is owner's responsibility.
5. Race fees excludes events (e.g., Gold Cup, East Coasts), Burnham Week and any other event not organised by the RCYC.
6. RCYC Mooring and Crane T&Cs apply.
7. Launch recovery to be booked in advance and recorded with RCYC Office.
8. Crane lifts and moorings are not transferable nor refundable.
9. Unused lifts are non-refundable and cannot be carried forward into subsequent years.
10. Exceptions must be agreed with Premises & Moorings Flag Officer.
11. Use of facilities are at owners' risk.
12. All boats must be adequately and currently insured.
13. All users must read the "terms and conditions" of the facilities.

**The club will clearly try and accommodate all the various fleets timing requirements but please note there is likely to have to be some flexibility at times (particularly Burnham Week)**

**Please be aware the club has no means to move RCODS once they are back on site after the winter currently, so the owners will need to arrange for boats to be moved to the crane area ahead of launching etc**
